This letter is to notify you that the street reclamation project in your neighborhood is proposed to be delayed to the 2019 construction season and be included with the 2019 street improvement program.

On January 2, 2018 you were sent an invitation to a neighborhood meeting for the proposed street reclamation project in your neighborhood for 2018. The neighborhood meeting took place on January 17, 2018. The purpose of that meeting was to provide information and receive comments on the proposed project for reference during preliminary design. Around the same time the Metropolitan Council notified the City of improvements they needed to make to their sanitary sewer pipes on River Hills Drive from Highway 13 to Lannon Court. The Metropolitan Council has determined that their proposed improvements will not begin until fall of 2018 or more likely spring of 2019. Due to the scope and impact of the Metropolitan Council's improvements, the City has decided to delay the street reclamation project.

You will be notified again regarding the project during the 2019 project development. We appreciate your patience as we move forward with rescheduling the project.
