When Do I Need a Building Permit?

The Protective Inspection Division works with contractors, tenants and property owners to ensure new construction and alterations to existing structures are code compliant.

Building Permits must be obtained before beginning any residential or commercial work that requires a permit. The qualified person responsible for doing the work must make the application for the required permits, which may include zoning, building, plumbing, mechanical, electrical, sign and grading permits.

The Following Work Requires Permits:

New construction, remodeling, additions or alterations to existing structures including, but not limited to:

-decks -basement finish -entry doors

-sheds (over 120 square feet.1) -siding -garages

-roofing -porches -windows

-fences (over 6 feet) -garage door replacement -swimming pools

-retaining walls -demolition -pole barns

Any replacement, alteration or moving of appliances and fixtures including, but not limited to:

-water heaters -ranges -furnace/boilers -gas fireplaces -exhaust fans -air conditioners

-water softeners -laundry facilities -water treatment systems

All mechanical, plumbing, electrical, water and sewer work (new or replacement) including, but not limited to

-fire protection systems -plumbing drain, waste, and vent

-mechanical vents/ductwork -gas piping

-fixture replacement (toilets, faucets, sinks) -water supply piping

-electrical devices/fixtures (outlets, switches, light fixtures) -irrigation systems

-septic systems -generators

1 Structures less than 120 sq. ft. in floor area and more than 50 sq. ft. in floor area require a Zoning Permit.
