

Open ice for hockey skaters ages 3+. Work on skating skills, drills and stick handling. Full equipment required for 17 and under. Helmets required for 18 and older. Scrimmages, games and lessons are not allowed.

Open Freestyle Ice & Developmental Hockey Ice

Figure or hockey skaters ages 3+ can work on skating skills and drills either individually or through private lessons with an instructor (skaters provide their own instructors). On-ice supervision and full equipment is required for any skater 17 years old or younger. Helmets are required for hockey skaters 18 and older.
