RECYCLE APPLIANCES, ELECTRONICS AND MORE IN BURNSVILLE ON JUNE 8

Part of I Love Burnsville Week June 1 - 8

Dakota County residents can recycle their old appliances, electronics and more during Burnsville's annual spring Appliance & Electronics Drop-Off on Saturday, June 8.

Who: Dakota County Residents
When: Saturday, June 8 | 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.
Where: Burnsville Maintenance Center, 13713 Frontier Court
Cost: FREE or small, per-item fee (*cash or check only*)

Items accepted at the drop-off, which is coordinated by Dakota Valley Recycling, include:

- Scrap metal such as lawn, garden and power tools – FLUIDS MUST BE DRAINED (FREE)
- Bicycles in any condition to be refurbished and donated (FREE)
- Appliances such as air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers, humidifiers, water softeners, ovens, microwaves, dishwashers and other miscellaneous items (FREE)
- Washers, dryers and water heaters (\$5 each)
- Miscellaneous electronics such as VCRs, DVD players, computers, computer accessories, stereos, digital cameras, fax equipment, or electronic gaming systems (\$5 each)
- Computer monitors and televisions (\$20-\$40 each)

Items NOT accepted at this event include:

- Hazardous waste such as aerosols, household batteries, cleaners, paint, light bulbs, pesticides, etc.; furniture; construction/demolition materials; vacuum cleaners; tires
