PUBLIC MEETING ON SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT STATEMENT FOR PROPOSED BURNSVILLE SANITARY LANDFILL EXPANSION

Meeting Hosted by Minnesota Pollution Control Agency Wednesday, July 10

In March 2019, the Burnsville City Council approved a Concept Planned Unit Development for Waste Management to increase the capacity of the Burnsville Sanitary Landfill (2650 Cliff Road, Burnsville). As the approval was only for a "concept plan," the project is subject to several additional reviews from other regulatory bodies before being brought forward for final consideration.

One such review is a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS), prepared by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA). In July, the MPCA will host a public meeting to gather feedback and suggestions about the scope of the SEIS.

What: Public Meeting on Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement

When: Wednesday, July 10, 2019

Open House: 6:30-7 p.m. Public Meeting: 7-9 p.m.

Where: Burnsville City Hall (Dakota Room), 100 Civic Center Parkway

The Open House will provide the public an opportunity to talk one-on-one with MPCA staff. The Public Meeting will begin with a brief presentation by the Burnsville Sanitary Landfill that will explain the proposed changes. This will be followed by a presentation from the MPCA to explain the SEIS process, and an opportunity to ask questions.

The public is invited to attend the meeting to suggest topics they believe the SEIS should cover. Topic suggestions will be considered by the MPCA as they draft the "scoping" document.
