FALL ARCHERY DEER HUNTS SCHEDULED FOR KELLEHER PARK

The Burnsville City Council has approved an archery deer hunt in one City park this fall as part of the City's ongoing Deer Management Program. Kelleher Park (14951 Burnsville Parkway), located in southwest Burnsville, was the park selected for this year's bow hunt.

The park hunt will be conducted by *Metro Bowhunters Resource Base* (MBRB). MBRB is a non-profit bow hunting group that assists metro communities with deer population management, and provides deer hunting opportunities to its members.

All participants for the fall hunts have been selected, and all hunters will have taken bow hunter training and passed a proficiency test before being allowed to hunt.

Hunts are scheduled in Kelleher Park from 5 a.m. to 7 p.m. on:

- Sept. 19 - 21
- Oct. 17 - 19
- Oct. 31 - Nov 2
- Nov. 14 - 16

Residents and park users should note that the park will be closed to the general public one hour prior to the hunt until one hour after the hunt.
