FEEDBACK WANTED ON PROPOSED TRASH RECEPTACLE ORDINANCE CHANGE

Comments Accepted In-Person at Nov. 25 Public Hearing or Online

The City of Burnsville is accepting public comment on a proposed ordinance change concerning trash receptacles.

Current Ordinance

City Code (§10-7-18 and 10-7-22) currently requires residential trash and recycling bins to be stored:

- Within an enclosed building OR
- Screened by buildings, berms, solid fences, walls, planting screens, evergreen trees, hedges or a grade change

Proposed Change

The proposed changes would allow receptacles to be stored:

- Within 5 feet of a garage or accessory structure OR
- Behind the primary structure/home

All screening provisions would be removed in the proposed ordinance.

Public Comment & Hearing

The proposed ordinance change will be presented at a public hearing on Monday, Nov. 25 at the Burnsville Planning Commission. The meeting starts at 6:30 p.m. and will be held in the City Council Chambers.

Comments received by noon on Nov. 21, 2019 will be included in the Planning Commission agenda packet. Comments received after that time will be printed and brought to the meeting in paper form.
