



PUBLIC HEARING

A public hearing on the City of Burnsville's Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) will be held by the Burnsville Parks and Natural Resources Commission at their regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 6, 2022 at 6:30 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway.

Those wishing to participate in the public hearing may have the option of appearing at the public hearing in person or electronically. The City's SWPPP is part of the requirements of a federal storm water permit program that is administered by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency. The overall goal of the program is to reduce the amount of sediment and pollution that enters surface and ground waters.

The public meeting will include a presentation that summarizes the City's annual report and highlights some of the required activities completed during the previous year. A copy of the City of Burnsville's SWPPP is available for review on the City's website (www.burnsvillemn.gov/swppp). The City will consider all comments and make reasonable adjustments to the SWPPP.
