February 18, 2024, while responding to a report of a domestic situation in

Burnsville; and

WHEREAS: Officer Paul Elmstrand dedicated over six years of service to the Burnsville Police

Department. He joined the department in 2017 as a Community Service Officer and was promoted to Officer in 2019. He served as part of the department's mobile command staff, peer team, Honor Guard, and field training unit; and

WHEREAS: Officer Paul Elmstrand will always be remembered by the colleagues that served

with him; and

WHEREAS: It is with deepest gratitude that the State of Minnesota recognizes Officer Paul

Elmstrand for his dedicated service to, and sacrifice for, his fellow Minnesotans.
