APPLICATIONS OPEN FOR BURNSVILLE ADVISORY COMMISSION POSITIONS

The Burnsville City Council is once again seeking residents interested in serving on City advisory commissions. These positions are appointed by the City Council and are responsible for researching, reviewing and making recommendations on issues.

All terms begin on July 1, 2025, and are open to Burnsville residents ages 18 and older. Youth commission appointments are open to any Burnsville resident that will be a high school student by fall of 2025. Membership on Economic Development Commission is open to non-residents who own a business or property in Burnsville.

The application deadline is Monday, May 5 at 4:30 p.m.

The City Council will conduct interviews for appointments in mid- to late-May. Opportunities for service are available on the following advisory commissions:

<u>Economic Development Commission:</u> Advisory body on economic development and business development.

Openings: Two Regular Members – three-year term

<u>Parks and Natural Resources Commission:</u> Advisory body that reviews and makes recommendations on issues related to park, recreation and open space needs and protection of Burnsville's natural resources.

Openings: Three Regular Member – three-year term
Two Youth Members – one-year term

<u>Planning Commission:</u> Advisory body that reviews, researches and makes recommendations on issues related to land use and development.

Openings: Two Regular Members – three-year term
