Burnsville Police Seek Public's Assistance With Information on Death

(WEDNESDAY, MAY 7, 2025 – BURNSVILLE, MN) – Burnsville Police are requesting the public's assistance with any information related to the death of a male adult in the early morning hours of Saturday, May 3, 2025, at Interlachen Park. Residents who may have witnessed anyone in the area between 1:00 am and 4:00 am or residents in the general area of the park with security camera footage with activity during these hours are asked to call Sergeant Lauren Olson at 952-641-1158.

"We are asking anyone who made have heard or saw anything to contact us," said Burnsville Sergeant Lauren Olson. "Businesses or residents with security footage that shows activity during this time can help us in our investigation into what happened."

Burnsville Police do not believe there is an ongoing threat to the public.
